
About The Kokomo Serra Club Ministry

Serra is an International Organization with three main objectives: to foster and promote vocations to the ministerial priesthood in the Catholic Church as a particular vocation to service, and to support priests in their sacred ministry; To encourage and affirm vocations to consecrated religious life in the Catholic Church; and to assist its members to recognize and respond in their own lives to God's call to holiness in Jesus Christ and through the Holy Spirit.

The Kokomo Serra Club meets on the first Wednesday and attends Mass together on the 3rd Sunday of every month. Wednesday meetings are usually held at St. Joan of Arc Church at 7:00 PM. On even months, we attend 9:00 AM Mass at St. Joan of Arc Church and on odd months we attend 8:00 AM Mass at St. Patrick Church. Our meetings usually involve a program/guest speaker.

Our social activities include a visitation with the Sisters at Tipton and a Clergy Recognition Banquet. Youth Activities include the Vocation Essay and Poster Contests for the children of the parishes. We have an Annual Day of Reflection and a Leadership Conference. We help sponsor the "Nun Run". We have an annual picnic for the seminarians and their families. We also provide Prayer Cards for seminarians and Deacon Candidates. We provide a Traveling Chalice for Sts. Joan and Patrick School.

BLESSED JUNIPERO SERRA, PRIEST

Known as "the Apostle of California" for his missionary work in North America, Miguel Jose Serra was born on the island of Mallorca, Spain. He took the name Junipero when he entered the Franciscan Order in 1730. Ordained in 1737, he taught philosophy and theology at the University of Padua for twelve years. At age 37, he went to Mexico City to work among the Indians. When Spain began its formal occupation of California, Serra joined the expedition, and in 1769 founded Mission San Diego. He spent the rest of his life working for the conversion of the peoples of the New World and is largely responsible for the spread of the Church on the West Coast. Junipero founded 21 missions, including San Gabriel, San Francisco, San Juan Capistrano and Santa Clara. A staunch defender of Native Americans, he introduced cattle, sheep, grains and the fruits of Mexico to their land, and converted thousands to the Faith. The campaign for his beatification began in 1934.
